Home Learning

You can help your child's learning at home by:

Maths overview

Understand and use place value and tens and units.

Read, write, use and compare numbers to 100

Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

Compare volume, capacity and mass

Explore position, movement and turns.

In Science, we will be learning to...

- Identify and compare deciduous and Evergreen trees
