The Aviva Community Fund gives funding to local projects that are making a positive change in their community which is why we have applied. It's quick and easy to register and vote, and your support is much appreciated – only projects with the most votes will become finalists, so every vote counts!

As many of you know, Friends of School have been working with the teaching staff to improve and enhance the outdoor facilities to increase opportunities for outdoor learning and physical activity. With the hard work and dedication of our parents and teachers during weekend work parties, we have already created an outdoor classroom and storage area called our 'castaway camp' and prepared the ground for seeding a wildflower meadow.

The next ambitious phase is beyond our fundraising capabilities. If we win this funding we can go ahead and develop the playing field by creating an all-weather track, this will be a firm and mud-free surface as it loops and meanders around the school sports pitch providing a fun and inclusive route for all children to run, walk, cycle or scoot.

Voting will open on 24 October and the projects with the most votes will become finalists. Anyone who registers on the Aviva Community Fund website can vote for projects between 24 October and 21 November. Once registered, you'll get 10 votes to cast, and we need everyone to vote and support our project so we can get through to the final. 
