### Home Learning

You can help your child's learning at home by:

- Hearing them read a variety of books and comics and reading to your child. Remember to fill in their reading records or help them keep a reading log.
- Helping them to practise their spelling words in a variety of ways, for a short time each day.
- Talk to them about their topics

## Home Learning Expectations

The expectation is that each child will read at least 4 times a week and learn weekly spellings which will be sent home. There will also be a weekly consolidation homework or topic homework.


<u>Problem solving</u> Solve problems including money. Explain choices and solutions orally and also record these.

- Extend our sentences with conjunctions.
