2016-17 Key Results

Early Years

74% of children in Reception class got a Good Level of Development (GLD). This is an increase on the previous year which was 62%.

Phonics Screening Test

83% of children in Year passed this test. This is an improvement on last year, which was 81%.

Key Stage 1 Tests (Year 2)

The children in year 2 are assessed in two ways formally: SATS and Interim Standards. Both results are listed below for Reading, Writing and Maths. These results also reflect an increase from last year.
